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## DAILY ITINERARY

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### Day 1, Friday 6<sup>th</sup> October

#### UK/Lourdes

Depart London Stansted for Lourdes. Upon arrival coach transfer to our hotel in Lourdes. Note: If we arrive at the hotel after 2 pm, your next meal will be evening dinner. Mass will be arranged in the next two days whilst in Lourdes. Due to the limited time we have in Lourdes, your private and personal devotion and prayers can be done during your free time. We will participate in the Rosary procession at 9pm.

### Day 2, Saturday 7<sup>th</sup> October

#### Lourdes

In consultation with our Spiritual Director, Father John Shewring, we will follow his itinerary. Mass will be celebrated today at one of the chapels in Lourdes, allowing time to pray the Rosary and Stations of the Cross on the high mountain, if possible as a group. You should have time for the Bathes in the healing water, visiting the Grotto and drinking from the miraculous spring water. Tonight, is the last night to participate in the blessing of the Sick and Torchlight procession.

### Days 3 & 4, Sunday/Monday 8<sup>th</sup> & 9<sup>th</sup> October - Lourdes/Loyola/Garabandal

*Garabandal the Blessed Virgin Mary appeared over 2,000 times from 2<sup>nd</sup> July,*

*1961 until 13<sup>th</sup> November, 1965. The four visionaries were simple unsophisticated girls, Conchita Gonzalez, Mari Loli Mazon, Jacinta Gonzalez and Mari Cruz Gonzalez, aged between 11 and 12.*

After breakfast, we leave Lourdes and travel by coach to Garabandal, via Loyola where we visit the birthplace of St Ignatius, the founder of the Jesuits order. We also visit the room in his family home behind the Sanctuary where he was taken when he was seriously wounded at the battle of Pamplona. This room is the most venerated of all. Continue to Garabandal, where we stay for two nights.

In Garabandal we visit the Pines where Our Lady appeared. We pray the Stations on the way up there and spend some time here for quiet reflection. After we come down we have Mass and afterwards we watch a video of the history of *Our Lady of Garabandal*. We tour around the village where we see the derelict homes of the seers. Dinner at the hotel.

### Day 5, Tuesday 10<sup>th</sup> October

#### Garabandal/Burgos

After breakfast, we leave Garabandal and travel to Burgos. Check-in to our hotel. Evening dinner at the hotel.

### Day 6, Tuesday 10<sup>th</sup> October

#### Burgos/Fatima

After breakfast, we celebrate Mass at the Burgos Cathedral. You have time to look around this magnificent cathedral. Afterward we board the coach and

continue our journey to Fatima. We should arrive on time for our evening dinner.

### Day 7, Wednesday 11<sup>th</sup> October

#### Fatima

During this very special centennial celebration, it might not be possible to do our own private celebration as a group but will participate as much activities as we possibly can in the Sanctuary. Evening dinner at the hotel. We will inform you of the schedule in the Sanctuary in the next few days of these two important days when it is released.

### Day 7, Thursday 12<sup>th</sup> May - Fatima

No private Masses or celebrations will be permitted today or tomorrow. Everyone participates in and follows the schedule organized by the Sanctuary of Fatima in the Square, together with thousands of other pilgrims arriving to celebrate this very special event.

### Day 8, Friday 13<sup>th</sup> October - Fatima

No private Masses or celebrations will be permitted today or tomorrow. Everyone participates in and follows the schedule organized by the Sanctuary of Fatima in the Square, together with thousands of other pilgrims arriving to celebrate this very special event.

**Note:** We will inform you of the schedule in the Sanctuary for these two important days when it has been

released.

### Day 9, Saturday 14<sup>th</sup> October- Fatima

After breakfast, we walk to the Sanctuary to celebrate Mass in St Joseph's chapel (if this is possible). Afterwards, we have a brief tour of the Sanctuary visiting the Chapel of Apparition, the Rosary Basilica where the tomb of the seers are buried. We have lunch at a nearby restaurant and afterwards we walk with the guide to catch the mini train and drop us off on the start of our prayer Stations of the Cross - the Hungarian Way of the Cross along Via Sacre to Valinhos where Our Lady appeared to the three children, Francisco, Jacinta and Lucia when they came out from prison. Then on to the village of Ajustrel, where the children lived with their families. **Note** - keep your mini train ticket for the return journey from Ajustrel to the Sanctuary. At 10:30 pm we participate in the Eucharistic prayer at the Outdoor Altar.

### Day 10, Sunday 15<sup>th</sup> October

#### Lourdes/UK

We leave the hotel very early for Lisbon and on to St Anthony's church (*the birthplace of St Anthony - The Patron of Lost Objects*). We celebrate Mass here and if time allows, we will make a brief tour of Lisbon and we proceed to the airport for your flight back to London Gatwick.
